

Student Money Advice Awards

Andrew Perry Memorial Award: Fund Administrator of the Year

Named in honour of Andrew Perry and his significant contribution to NASMA's Hardship Funds Committee, this award will be made to an individual who has excelled in the field of administering funds to students.

This could be an individual whose core job role includes the assessment of fund applications, or an individual who has excelled at creating/reviewing a fund, introducing new administration procedures, or managing a fund in such a way that the positive impact on students is significant. I.e. This is not about the job title, but about the success that has been achieved within the arena of fund administration.

Nominees should demonstrate equity and fairness in their approach whilst also considering the impact of their work on the wider student experience, and/or making a contribution to student money advice more generally, that is over and above the call of duty and in line with the [NASMA Values](#).

Nominees could make this significant contribution within their own team or institution/SU, or within the sector more widely, such as involvement with NASMA committees, representing NASMA on sector groups, or providing supportive expertise to colleagues.

Nominees can be anyone registered as a NASMA member in the current membership year, either as an individual member, or as part of an educational membership. If you are not sure whether an individual or team are NASMA members, contact the NASMA Office via office@nasma.org.uk
